



TIPS FOR ONLINE CLASSES



• IF THE CHILD IS USING SPECTACLES
MAKE HIM WEAR THEM.

• BE ON TIME FOR THE CLASS AND
PREFERABLY LOG IN 5 MINUTES EARLY.



• IF CHILD HAS MINI MIC OR FM SYSTEM
PLEASE USE IT TO AMPLIFY LISTENING

• ADJUST THE BRIGHTNESS FOR YOUR
CHILD BEFORE THE SESSION



• LARGE SCREEN DEVICE SHOULD BE USED SUCH AS
LAPTOP/IPAD/DESKTOP THAN SMART PHONES

• THE LIGHTING NEEDS TO BE APPROPRIATE TO
ENSURE THE CHILD CAN SEE THE SCREEN PROPERLY.

- SELECT A CORNER / SEATING WHICH WOULD BE USED DAILY.

- DRESS THE CHILD IN UNIFORM/ APPROPRIATE CLOTHES.

- BOOKS AND STATIONARIES TO BE KEPT HANDY TO TAKE NOTES.

- AVOID DISTRACTIONS. ENSURE THERE IS SILENCE DURING THE SESSION (NO CONVERSATIONS, TV, RADIO ,HOUSEHOLD CHORES)



- AVOID SITTING NEAR A WINDOW TO REDUCE BACKGROUND DISTURBANCES.

- THE SEATING CHAIR HEIGHT NEEDS TO BE APPROPRIATE AND ENSURE CHILD'S FEET ARE FIRMLY PLACED/ SUPPORTED WELL (NOT DANGLING).

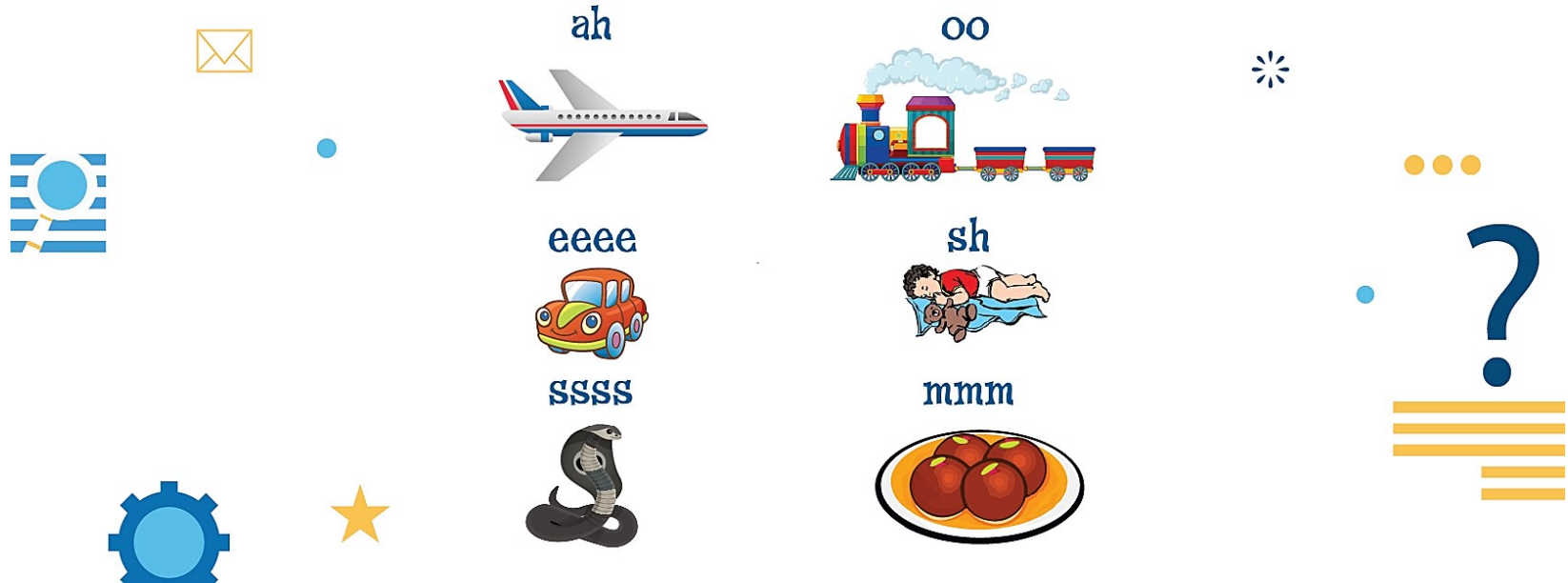

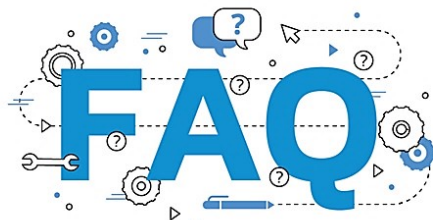

Q. What are Ling 6 sounds, why are they used, what is their importance?

Ans: The Ling 6 sounds represent the different frequencies of speech sounds from low to high pitch. These sounds are /mm/ /aa/ /ee/ /oo/ /shh/ /sss/. They are used to test the child's hearing and check whether they have access to the entire range of speech sounds required to learn spoken language. It is used to test whether the child can detect each of the sounds and in time identify them i.e. recognise each sound across the speech spectrum.

What is Self-Advocacy?

Why is it important for caregivers and children with hearing loss?

ANSWER



Self-Advocacy is the ability to effectively communicate about your needs, goals, interests, desires and rights.

- It is about 'speaking up' and 'asking the right questions' and 'making appropriate requests'
- Knowledge about hearing, hearing loss, the hearing device and parts of the hearing device.
- Self- advocacy is a key educational component in a child's life, regardless of age.

a) Cochlear implant processor?

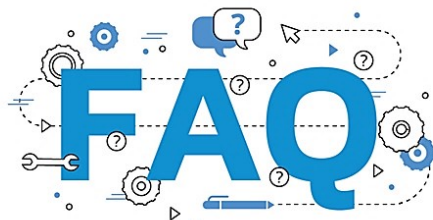
Ans: For cochlear implant rechargeable batteries or 675 implant plus disposable batteries can be used. Implant plus is mentioned on the strip.

b) Hearing aids?

Ans: For hearing Aids 675 zinc air disposable batteries can be used.

What is Auditory Verbal Therapy (AVT)?

ANSWER

Auditory Verbal Therapy is an early intervention approach, used to teach infants and young children with hearing loss to develop language and learn to 'listen and talk'. This is possible by using right hearing technology such as hearing aids, cochlear implants and the use of assistive listening devices (mini mic or FM system). Caregivers are the child's most important teachers, they are coached and guided to use different strategies, techniques and procedures to enable their child to be mainstreamed into regular school along with their typical hearing peers and become a contributing member of society.
