About Us

VConnect Foundation is a not-for-profit parent support group for children with hearing loss, and caters to families from diverse backgrounds and income levels. It is a supportive network for families of children who use listening and spoken language to communicate.

VConnect was founded in 2007 by Vahishtai J Daboo and Fatema Jagmaag, both of whom are parents and leading professionals in the field of hearing health. Vahishtai is a Listening and Spoken Language Specialist, Certified Auditory Verbal Therapist (LSLS Cert. AVT) and a Trained in Narrative Practice. She has been practising in the field for over 19 years.

Fatema Jagmaag is a Senior Audiologist and Speech/Language Pathologist. She has been practising in the field for over 36 years and is associated with premium hospitals and institutions.

VConnect's purpose is to support, educate, empower, provide hope and guidance to parents in their journey to mainstream their children as successful contributing members of society. The purpose is achieved by creating platforms and networks for the holistic development of children.

Strength of VConnect Foundation

VConnect has over 1500 parents spread across various circles located across India and internationally. Our team comprises of a committed team of 42 persons most of whom work in an honorary capacity and volunteer their time to the organisation.

VConnect has its circles in 10 cities in India.

Mission, Vision and Focus Areas

Our vision and mission is to mainstream children with hearing loss by:

- providing hope and empowerment to their parents and primary caregivers
- co-creating an ecosystem that fosters a culture of inclusiveness

We have identified four key focus areas based on our mission and vision given below:

- 1) Education
- 2) Mental Health
- 3) Knowledge Hub
- 4) Advocacy

Based on these key focus areas several initiatives and programs are implemented and continue to be implemented by various VConnect teams as detailed in the activity report below.

Education

To integrate children into mainstream schools successfully.

Mainstream Guide

The VConnect mainstream guide which was created with the purpose of mainstreaming children with hearing loss is available in four languages - English, Hindi, Gujarati and Marathi. The same can be downloaded from the resource section of the VConnect website Resources – VConnect Foundation

Distribution of Mainstream Guides:

100 Mainstream Guides in Hindi language, were distributed through the Hear Me Speak during Diwali in their Joy of Listening Boxes to 100 families.

Shiksha Series

Based on need by parents, VConnect Foundation started a new series of webinars called **Shiksha Series** from August 2021. This series is based on different aspects of **Academics & Education**. This series of webinars is conducted on the first Friday of every month and covers a range of topics that help the caregivers to understand how to work with their children on the different aspects of education, academics and life skills, which will contribute to the child's overall advancement. VConnect has collaborated with Dr. Mihir Parekh, a Child Psychologist, Special Educator and an Author to conduct this series.

To nurture the mental health of caregivers and children.

The Mental Health focus area works on Parent Peer Support by conducting workshops for caregivers and Teenage Support where teenagers and young adults receive support. Besides this the team also strives to create awareness and sensitization about mental health in the community.























Teenager Support Sessions

VConnect recognised the need to support the mental health of teenagers and started Teenager Peer Support sessions from 11th April 2021. These sessions are conducted by Aashi Doshi, Nupur Chowdhary and Jehan VJ Daboo under the guidance of the Mental Health team. The intention and focus are to enable the teenagers to be able to speak up for themselves, feel more confident about themselves and their abilities and to build up a better self concept for themselves. The idea stemmed from the fact that we know the pandemic has not been easy on teenagers with hearing loss as it's led to isolation and loss of confidence in themselves and their communication skills. The sessions consist of interaction, activities and sharing of thoughts, ideas and information that is catered to the teenagers who attend. We conduct 2 sessions every month, one in English and one in Hindi/Marathi.



Total **82** teenagers attended these sessions.
















Creating Awareness about Mental Health on World Mental Health Day





















Cochlear Implant Day



On 20th December 2021, a wonderful activity for advocating children about the cochlear implant was conducted. Children came up with questions and got to know a lot about their processor.

Music Programme

Music enables children with hearing loss to enhance their listening skills. They learn to listen to the finer nuances of music, enabling better listening skills, which in turn enables the child to develop better speech and language. Together, these skills aid in better social emotional development, leading to better literacy and academic skills. Songs introduce and reinforce new vocabulary and syntax; they

have a lot of repetition which is very essential for children with hearing loss to learn language. Music is a prevalent and engaging part of everyday life, it gives children pleasure, and improves the quality of life of children.

VConnect Foundation in collaboration with **Sound Space** conducts weekly music sessions for children upto 12 years. Sessions are conducted once a week in 2 batches.

19 children are regularly attending music sessions.

Children Performing at Chhatrapati Shivaji Vastu Sangrahalaya Museum, Mumbai





Speech and Drama Programme

1) Speech & Drama Summer Camp:

A five day **Speech and Drama** summer camp was organised in the month of May for the children of **VConnect Foundation** from 4 to 12 years of age in two different batches. This was conducted in collaboration with the prestigious speech and drama organisation, **Expressions Unlimited**, **Pune**. Children thoroughly enjoyed the sessions and this showed in their 100% attendance. These sessions were conducted online through the Zoom platform.

A total of **18** children participated in the Speech and Drama sessions everyday for 5 days.





2) Regular Speech & Drama Classes in collaboration with The Create Foundation:

VConnect Foundation has collaborated with **The Create Foundation**, which is founded by theatre personality, Raell Padamsee, to conduct weekly on-line sessions for our children. Children from across India participate in these wonderfully curated sessions conducted by expert trainers.

Speech and Drama is a fun way to improve children's speech, language and confidence, enabling them to feel confident in speaking up, conversing, talking in public, acting, making presentations and advocating for themselves.

The entire Speech and Drama programme is headed by Ms. Pina Chowdhary, our VConnect Ambassador. The following activities are being conducted in collaboration with The Create Foundation:

A) Speech and Drama Classes: Speech and Drama classes with The Create Foundation commenced online for children 9 years and above, from 11th October 2021 and are conducted every Monday at 4pm. This group of children put up a fantastic performance at the 15th VConnect Annual Day Celebration - 'The Lofty Trees'.




14 children are a part of this Speech and Drama Class.

Advocacy - To advocate the need for an inclusive ecosystem

New Born Hearing Screening

VConnect Foundation submitted a proposal to Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) - Chief Medical Officer in February 2021 to make Universal New Born Hearing Screening (UNBHS) - a mandate in the BMC hospitals.

In November 2021, the same proposal was also submitted to the Health Ministry in New Delhi through the representation made by the Cochlear Implant Group of India-CIGI.


On our 15th Founder's Day at VConnect's Virtual International Conference, we invited the Speaker of Vidhan Sabha and the Joint Commissioner of Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) to inaugurate our International Conference as well as to impress upon and advocate to the Government agencies about the importance and need for New Born Hearing Screening (NBHS), so that it can be made mandatory in the BMC Hospitals. Post our interactions with the Government agencies, they have taken a very proactive step of conducting awareness drives, emphasising on the need for UNBHS, on The World Hearing Day. There was a message sent out by a number of celebrities stressing the need to test every child's hearing at birth, naming the hearing tests mandated to be done at birth.

Hamare Adhikar / Our Rights

Ms. Jigna Sanchania has been appointed as the lead facilitator for Hamare Adhikar/Our Rights series. She, along with her team, researches and puts together the entire programme across a range of topics ranging from rights, benefits, concessions that families can avail in education, income tax and the different travel concessions. Right to Education, how to make a disability certificate, how to make the UDID card, where can one go and how can one avail of these services, this is all shared with the families in the different workshops conducted. There are different statewise concessions and benefits, rules and regulations, all of this is well documented and shared to make the process of availing these benefits smoother and easier for the families. All the resource material is created in four languages - Hindi, Gujarati, Marathi and English and is available in the resource section of the VConnect website Resources – VConnect Foundation




The International Week Of The Deaf:

World Hearing Day 2022:




